
# **Nursery Update**

The children have returned from their Christmas break bursting with enthusiasm about our new topic 'People who help us'. Throughout the half term, the children will earn about a variety of professions including doctors and nurses, dentists, police and firefighters. They will have the opportunity to visit a fire station and experience first-hand what it is like to be a firefighter. They will also have visits to the Nursery from parents who work as doctors and in the police force.

This week the children have enjoyed using the doctor's surgery to role play either being a patient or a medical practitioner. They have made their own medical bag to use if faced with a first aid emergency and created their own x-rays using white paint. We have also begun our phase 2 phonics programme identifying words which begin with the 'S' phoneme.
