School Streets Programme – Consultation

We have been working with Wandsworth Council on a potential scheme as part of the Council's School Streets programme.

The Council will be holding two drop-in sessions to discuss the programme. Please come along to give your views on traffic issues around the school and get involved in helping the Council shape a plan for the local area. The sessions will take place on:

Wednesday 13 December, 4.30pm – 6.30pm, Webb's Road Monday 18 December, 4.30pm – 6.30pm, Meteor Street

There will also be information available in the playgrounds at pick-up, 3.15pm, on the same dates (13 Dec – Webb's, 18 Dec – Meteor).

The drop-in sessions will form part of the initial discussion around a potential School Streets scheme and other concerns residents might have. All feedback will be analysed and fed into a proposal drafted by engineers and presented in a formal consultation in early 2024. If supported, the Council will launch a trial scheme in April 2024.

Nursery Update

The Nursery are well underway with their topic of "Celebrations" this term.

The children have explored pumpkins and made magical potions in our first week back. They sat around a pretend bonfire (toasting real marshmallows and chocolate milk) to celebrate Bonfire night. They learned about the Rama and Sita story during Diwali week and found out why it is important to remember soldiers who have fought in wars during the week of Remembrance.



This week, Birthday Week, culminates in a birthday party for Fred the Phonics Bear. Children have been practising party games (pass the parcel and musical statues) in preparation for the phonic bear's 4th birthday. Whilst these games seem like fun to the children, they are also helping them to follow instructions and take turns - important foundations within the Early Years Curriculum.



Both classes have been eagerly learning the songs for our Christmas concerts, which will be happening next week.
