We are so proud of the Reception children's performances in the Nativity plays this week. Well done!
































# **Year 3 Update**

We have been incredibly busy this half term in Year 3. After launching our history topic on Roman Day, the children have since learnt a lot more about the Romans. One lesson included a two-sided debate as Senators to inform Emperor Claudius of the reasons for and against invading Britain. The Emperor listened to both sides of the argument, deliberated very hard and made the decision to invade!









In science, we have learnt so much about forces and magnets. We received a very exciting letter asking for out help to investigate whether all materials were magnetic and then had to take our learning one step further by investigating if all metals are magnetic. We have learnt about contact and non-contact forces and tried to explain the difference between them. To finish off our topic the children made their own 'magnet mazes'.

In English, we have spent the last few weeks writing the 13th Labour of Hercules, after reading Hercules, The World's Strongest Man. It has been wonderful to see the creativity of all the children's writing and how well they've learnt to use speech in a story.

We are looking forward to our concert, DT, and end of term activities next week!
