Eco-Council visit Wandsworth Recycling Centre

On Monday, the eco-council took a trip to the Wandsworth recycling centre to see the process of how our household rubbish is recycled correctly. The children were able to see how the rubbish arrives at the centre and how it is sorted to ensure the different materials are appropriately recycled. The children visited the education centre where they asked thoughtful questions, expanding their knowledge, and were praised for their hard work in ensuring recycling happens at Belleville. Did you know that an average class can save up to twenty trees a year if they recycle their paper and resources!

'I found out that you could turn plastic bottles into all kind of items such as tables and t-shirts.' – Barnaby, Year 3.

'Did you know they load about 90 shipping containers of general waste a day on a big barge which are shipped to Bexley to be burned up to create electricity.' – Mahault, Year 5.
