




Belleville School PTA Winter Fair - Saturday 3 December

Year 1

Following on from their learning about *The Tiger Who Came to Tea* (and to our classrooms - roarsome!), children are now learning about persuasive writing. At the end of the famous story, Sophie and her family go to their favourite café. This week, children are imagining their own cafés and thinking about the delicious food and drink they would sell. They are using persuasive language to persuade the reader that their café is the best!







Year 1 have been super scientists this week learning about absorbency. The clumsy teachers spilt some water so the children tested which material was the most absorbent and should be used to help clean up the mess! They decided paper towels were the most absorbent.

In maths, children have been using ten frames to work out number sequences. They have been focusing on finding one more and one less than a number.

This week in ICT, the children have been learning about data. The children found out how to collect data and how we can use this data. We took class surveys on our favourite ice cream flavour and made our class bar chart using the Teaching Graphs app on the iPads. We were all impressed with the children's problem solving and teamwork skills whilst creating their bar charts.
