Following on from last term's topic 'Microbes in our lives,' we were incredibly lucky to have a visit from Dr Charlotte Odendall, whose son is in 4JM, and Owen. They taught the children more about microbes and helped them to build on their knowledge from Science lessons.

The children had the opportunity to create a hypothesis for an investigation to find out the effect of cleaning their hands. They were each given a petri dish. On one side, they wiped their fingers before washing them and, on the other, they used hand sanitiser before wiping their fingers again.
