Year 6 hear Baroness Floella Benjamin at the BFI

On 28 June, Year 6 visited the BFI for a truly inspiring event with Baroness Floella Benjamin. The pupils first watched "Coming to England", a film based on her experience of leaving Trinidad to start a new life in England. Children were amazed to learn that Benjamin had travelled with her three siblings (the oldest of whom was 11) and no adults! The highlight of the event, however, was hearing her message: she spoke of the three C's (consideration, confidence, and contentment); the power to say "no" to making the wrong choices (for example, resisting the temptation to use screens); and how to stand up to bullying.

Children from Belleville, as well as other schools, were completely rapt in the company of one of 24 holders of the Order of Merit. Hopefully, Year 6 will remember her words about education being a passport to life as they move on to their new schools. The event culminated with several of our children asking questions before Year 6 had the opportunity to have a photograph with Floella.
