Year 1 Update


Year 1 children have been being super scientists this term by identifying different animal groups. They met several different types of animals when ZooLab came to visit and, more recently, children have been investigating what animal scat can teach us about their diets. We used the scat to identify whether an animal is a herbivore, omnivore, or carnivore. How exciting!







This week we launched our new Geography topic and were being adventure detectives to discover where Fred had been on holiday over half term, using these clues from his backpack. We can't wait to find out more about countries around the world this half term!







In maths, we have been busy learning how to tell the time to o'clock and half past. The children have been using the little clocks to learn how to read the time, show the time and have had a go at drawing the hands on a clock. The children have even been estimating time. In the picture, you can see the children estimating time by looking up when they 'estimated' one minute had passed. It is much more challenging than you think!
