A School Street is a scheme to restrict traffic to create a safer, calmer, cleaner environment. The proposal is to restrict traffic on Belleville Road between 8.20am – 9.10am and 3pm – 3.40pm on school days. #### Year 3 Update

The children in Year 3 have been incredibly busy since half term, learning all kinds of new things!

In science, we are studying Geology and have been learning about different types of natural rocks and how they are formed. We created a model of this using Starburst, which was a fantastic way for children to visualise the rock formation. Later this half term, we will visit the Natural History Museum to discover their huge range of different rocks and minerals, as well as take part in a 'Dino Dig'.



Our geography topic this half term is 'Can we only eat local?' We launched this topic by exploring a range of fruits, locating where they came from using an atlas and then enjoying a delicious fruit salad! Since then, children have explored seasonality and what this means for consumers. As well as the distance fruit and vegetables have to travel to arrive in the UK.

In English, we have been exploring books written by the author Atinuke. The children have written an information text about Nigeria, after reading the book Africa, Amazing Africa. We have also read The No.1 Car Spotter, where the children have written a persuasive advertisement and a diary entry.
