We were really pleased to welcome Lizzie and her team back to the school before half term – the children loved their workshops (even in their Jubilee day costumes).



World Class Visitor Wows Years 4 and 5



Donald Lamont, is not only great-uncle of one of our pupils but is also Chairman of the UK Antarctic Heritage Trust and the Chairman of *Endurance 22* whose mission was to find the wreck of the ship *Endurance* in Antarctica 107 years after it sunk.

Children in Years 4 and 5 are already familiar with the story of Shackleton and the story of exploration, determination and survival.

Mr Lamont explained how he got involved in the project, the difficulties of finding the wreck, the technology and science used and his feelings of relief that they had safely succeeded after taking on this brave but risky mission. The children were suitably impressed and will be looking out for the documentary being produced by the team in 2023.

Mr Lamont also fed back to us:

'I was so impressed by the enthusiasm, discipline and intelligent questions of your children. The enthusiasm was extraordinary and the questions impressively sensible and intelligent.'
