
# Could you share your (or someone you know's) knowledge or expertise?

There is a maths opportunity to the right but any offers are very welcome – simply email the school.


# Do you use maths in 'real life'?



Maths Week will be taking place from the 11th -15th July across the Trust. During this time, we aim to further develop children's love of maths, and help them to see the real-world application of their learning.


