These four pieces from Belleville have been chosen from the 33,000 entrants to be exhibited either online or in the gallery. Well done to everyone who got involved!





Year I children had a fabulous day experiencing life as a Victorian schoolchild. They had very strict teachers in their class and visiting them over Zoom from Holly Lodge.








