



NEW TO POST SENCO PROGRAMME AT BELLEVILLE

This programme has been designed to provide new-to-post SENCOs with some ground level advice and tools.

The main aim of the course is to help participants put the theory and guidance learnt during the National SENCO certificate training courses into practice in a practical and achievable way. There will be opportunities for case study practice and sharing effective practice.

The programme consists of four full-day training sessions, focusing on key topics such as:

- Legal requirements from the SEN code of practice
- Policy guidance
- Chairing or coordinating multi-agency meetings
- Intervention planning and staff deployment
- Tracking and record keeping
- Statements/EHCP plan procedures
- Intervention resources
- Support resources
- Assessment resources
- Key agencies and what they do to aid decisions of next steps/signposting and how to refer to them
